A time slot for rotating art display at Eustis Memorial Library will be from 11 May through 11 August - please contact Esther 216-513-7314 or esp.bluelake@gmail.com to make a commitment - approximately 15 small or 8 large works or a combination of both (more will fit) - one artist may stay the full three months with switching out paintings to provide interest or three artists may take one month each - flexibility is possible; is open to Eustis art League as well so it is important to call Esther if interested, so we can book the arrangement we want to establish.

Also available during the same time are a small display case for jewelry, art presented flat, or sculpture pieces AND a large standing display case with removable shelves to hold vertical pieces of art, paintings, needle work, jewelry, etc. Please call Esther with preferences and the kind of art you want to display.

In the Trust Department of the First National Bank in Mount Dora - 6 large pieces may be set up on three floors. If you are new to displaying your art, Esther will arrange to go with you and introduce you to the people in charge at any of our venues for rotating art displays. Esther's Bookshelf

NF - Biography - A BEAUTIFUL MIND by Sylvia Nasar. The life of mathematical genius and Nobel Laureate John Nash who was a legend by age 30 when he slipped into madness. Because of the selflessness of his beautiful wife and the loyalty of the mathematics community, Nash emerged after decades of ghost-like existence to win a Nobel Prize and world acclaim. Well written and inspiring - a drama about the mystery of the human mind, triumph over incredible adversity, and the healing power of love. An excellent movie with the same title was based on Nasar's book starring Russell Crowe as John Nash. Though I had read this book years ago and also seen the movie, I recently listened to the unabridged audio book read by Edward Hermann and am presenting this biography as well worth the time expended.

F - GIRL WITH A PEARL EARRING by Tracy Chevalier. Another book out of the past and one I recently enjoyed again by unabridged audio narrated by Ruth Ann Phimister is a recreation of 17th Century artist Johannes Vermeer in this haunting work of historical fiction. In 1664 sixteen-year old Griet enters the Vermeer household as a servant, eventually becoming one of Vermeer's subjects. "A vibrant, sumptuous novel . . . beautifully written . . . mirrors the elegance of the painting that inspired it." Chevalier "fills this unusual love story with the shades, sounds, and textures of everyday life in Holland."

Booker Prize-winning novel (1992) - THE ENGLISH PATIENT by Michael Ondaatje. "Sensuous, mysterious, rhapsodic - this poetic writing "transports the reader to another world, and uncovers that world's connection to our own." With ravishing beauty and unsettling intelligence, Ondaatje's work traces the intersection of four damaged lives in an Italian villa at the end of World War II. Excellent! Also a beautifully scenic film is available based on this "intensely theatrical tour de force."

DVDs recently revisited - powerful and emotionally moving:

THE PAINTED VEIL starring Edward Norton and Naomi Watts based on a novel by Somerset Maugham - set in colonial era Shanghai - a cholera-ravaged village deep in China, against the drama of a nation in turmoil. Involves love and redemption.

<u>PATRIOT'S DAY - 4 stars - "a great American movie"</u> starring Mark Wahlberg, Kevin Bacon, John Goodman - based on true events - "showcases the bravery and heart of everyday heroes" of the 2013 terrorist attack on Boston's Marathon Day.

WONDER starring Julia Roberts, Owen Wilson, Jacob Tremblay (2000) - based on the beloved novel by R. J. Placio. Inspiring and uplifting story of the Pullman family whose youngest child Auggie was born with facial differences requiring 27 surgeries following birth - proves that one cannot blend in when one was born to stand out. Mainstreamed into an elementary school for the first time, Auggie's extraordinary journey unites his family, his school, and his community. Keep the Kleenex handy.
